Island Brewery Tennyson IPA \mid 4.5% \mid A traditional IPA combining, Simcoe and Cascade hops to produce an exciting full flavoured pale ale.

Bosuns Down the Hatch | 4.0% | This blonde beer has a fruity citrus nose. Brewed using American Cascade hops as its main hop it has a citrus taste with a hint of lemon. Although it has a good hoppy taste, it remains a great session beer.

Woodfordes Nelson's Revenge | 4.5% | Rich and floral aromas, sweet Norfolk malts and a burst of 'citrus' hops embody this mouth-watering premium beer. Revenge is a chestnut-coloured ale, best served bittersweet. Our wholehearted harmony of hops, fruits and barley pays homage to brave Admiral Nelson and his crew. Nelson's is a Norfolk beer, and glory in the taste and aromas of citrus and Norfolk malts we've crammed in.

Ainsty Killer Kiwi | 5.0% | Our New World IPA, Triple-Hopped with New Zealand Pacific Gem, Rakau & Nelson Sauvin hops, then dry-hopped to give a clean crisp IPA with notes of tropical fruit....a real Summer favourite!

Downton New Forest | 3.8% | A bronze coloured best bitter. A combination of roasted malts and rich, aromatic hops provide a well-rounded flavour and a distinctive hoppy bitterness.

Firebrand Bootleg Billy | 4.0% | A sessionable 4% Amber Ale, Bootleg Billy is sweet and malty alongside a hint of floral and raisin.

Named after the Cornish Smuggler William Pearse, the only person to be hanged for Wrecking. That fateful day just so happened to be in our hometown of Launceston.

Pennine Lions in the Heart | 3.9% | A mellow Resinous and spicy bitterness leading to a lime citrus and sherbet aftertaste.

Roosters Buckeye | 3.5% | Named after a rare breed of chicken that originates from the state of Ohio in the USA, Buckeye is an easy-drinking, well-hopped pale ale, brewed with a blend of American and New Zealand hops, producing an orange, citrus fruit aroma and a refreshing level of bitterness.

Settle Northern Light | 4.0% | A delicate blonde ale with a light malt character and a sessionable hoppy finish.

Cerne Abbas Gurt Coconuts Rum Stout | 6.7% | A silky, supple and comforting Gentle Giant of a beer, matured in rum casks. Its Gurt, its rum, its coconutty. Vic successfully conducted one of his experiments with his old oak rum cask with no black sticky explosions.

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
